

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Statement of Purpose:

This agreement has been entered into by Pine Technical College (PTC) and University of Minnesota, Crookston (UMC). The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate credit transfer and provide students a smooth transition from PTC to one related degree program at UMC. It is recognized that the attached appendixes shall describe the program of study at PTC, required for transfer admission to UMC and the Business Management program (Management emphasis).

Terms and Conditions of Credit Transfer:

The parties of this agreement hereby agree to the terms and condition set forth herein.

The evaluation and transfer of earned college credits shall be in full compliance with the University of Minnesota, Crookston policies and all other state and federal education policies pertaining to undergraduate credit transfer. See the admissions section in the current college catalog or <http://www1.umn.edu/commpub/umc/admission.html> for details.

Students who have completed an Associate of Science Degree in Business Administration at PTC with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better may transfer 60 credit hours of course work towards the Business Management baccalaureate program at UMC. PTC program specific requirements and/or required courses are listed in Appendix A. Students who have not completed the degree requirements at PTC are eligible for credit evaluation at UMC.

Transfer students will have to comply with the admission requirements (GPA, admissions testing, etc.) at the University of Minnesota, Crookston. See the admissions section in the current college catalog or <http://www1.umn.edu/commpub/umc/admission.html> for details.

Applicants accepted to the UMC program must fulfill the graduation requirements of the granting institution. A recommended sequence of courses to complete the graduation requirements is identified in Appendix B.

Upon student request, each institution will forward to the other copies of transcripts from students in the program.

Both institutions will inform potential students about this program. To facilitate the success of this partnership, Pine Technical College agrees to:

- Waive the transcript request fee for students requesting a transcript be sent to UMC.
- Place a link to UMC on its web site.

The Chief Academic Officers or designee of the collaborating institutions shall be responsible for implementing this agreement, for identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, and for conducting a periodic review of this agreement.


This agreement becomes effective on March 1, 2002, and remains in effect until terminated or amended by either party.






