ONLINE COURSE REGISTRATION PRIORITY

Online degree-seeking students are given priority for registration in all online courses (designated by class sections E90 & E91). Students who have not been admitted to one of the UMC's approved online degree programs may not register in any online courses until open enrollment (April 24).

During queued registration stages 1-9 (April 6-23), online courses will **only** be open for registration to students officially enrolled in an approved online degree program. This will insure that "place-bound" students have the first opportunity to enroll in online classes. Beginning on Friday, April 24th, registration in online courses will be open to all students on a space available basis.
